COURSE OF FIRE

CENTREFIRE 200m

- 5 x fly targets plus an optional warmer target.
- No sighters once competition begins.
- 25 scoring shots.
- 5 minute details

RIMFIRE 100m

- 5 x fly targets plus an optional warmer target.
- 3 sighters per target.
- 25 scoring shots.
- 7 minute details

COSTS

- \$25 per night.

PRIZES

- \$10 goes to range fees and targets,
- \$5 in the pot for nightly winner
- \$10 in the pot for overall 1st place nightly
- Top three results from four competition nights combined to determine overall winners with cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

TIMES

Range open by 6.30pm. Competition starts when the sun sets. Please arrive by 7 if you can, to help set up.

CLASS RULES

- Any standard hunter or varmint rifle from major manufacturers.
- No custom guns/actions or designated TARGET models
- Single shots permitted as long as it is a factory single shot.
- Factory calibres only. No wildcats.
- Re-Barrels allowed as long as calibre, profile and twist rate match those of a factory version of that rifle make/Model (gun must be able to chamber a loaded factory cartridge (no tight chambers)
- No flat forends. Forend width limited to 2.5 inches. No attachments other than a bipod permitted.
- Stocks to be of design/shape/weight of factory stock for that make and model.
- Scope power limited to 25x. Larger variable magnification scopes to be taped at 25x or lower.
- Muzzle brakes not permitted
- Magazine loading and shooting permitted by approval of Range Officer on the night.
- No custom/joystick/sandbag style front rests permitted. Bipods or rolled up towels etc permitted.
- Weight limit of 5kg plus an extra 750g for bipods if attached. Tolerance of +/- 50grams
- In the event of a dispute in relation to a firearms legality for this match the Wagga match organisers will speak with the competitor and make a determination. Decisions are final. If in doubt please contact us.
- Rimfire – ONLY high velocity or hollow point ammunition permitted. Random checks will occur.
